

Santa Ana Community Safety Snap Shot



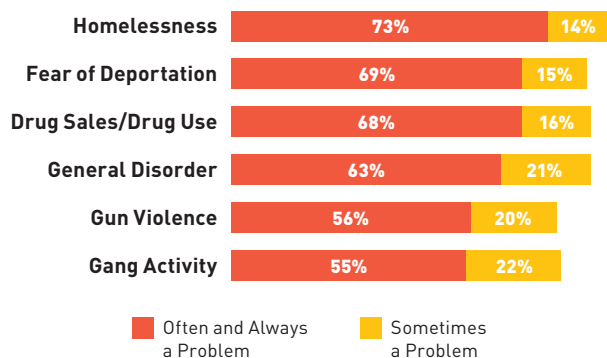
OVERVIEW

Santa Ana Building Healthy Communities (SABHC) in partnership with Urban Peace Institute (UPI) published a larger report highlighting top safety issues among residents in Santa Ana. The Community Safety Assessment Report (CSAR) findings include:

- Homelessness, Fear of Deportation, and Drug Sales/Use are among the top 3 safety concerns
- Schools and Family are the most effective in addressing safety while Law Enforcement and Elected Officials are the least effective
- Over the last 5 years, Santa Ana has experienced a 62% increase in homicides
- Public trust and credibility of SAPD is only half of what it should be

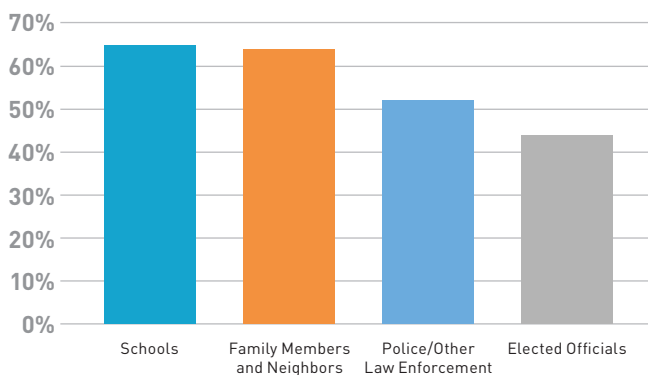
Santa Ana's "business as usual" is not working. Residents are not getting what they ask for or the public safety they are paying for.

TOP SAFETY ISSUE IN SANTA ANA



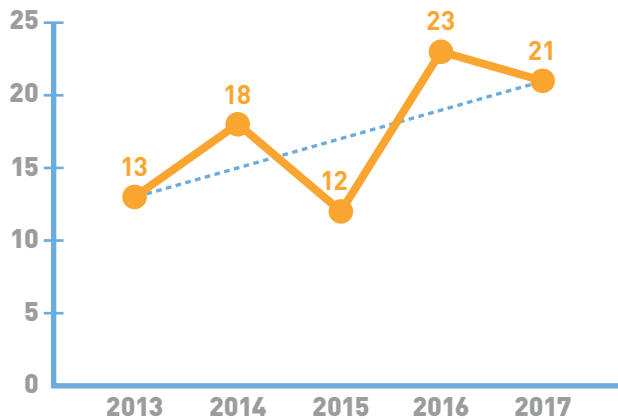

How effective do you think each of the following groups/agencies has been in improving safety?



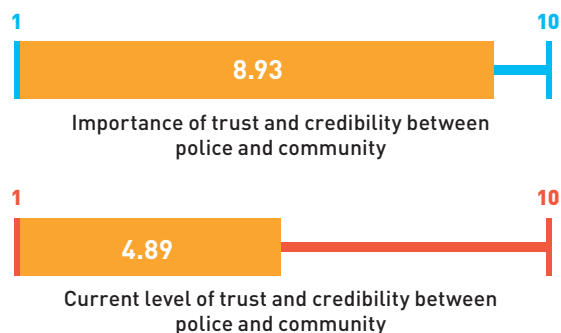
